How to Renew Your Practising Certificate

- (1) Complete the application form (enclosed). No correction fluid/tape should be used on the application form. Any amendments, corrections or alterations made must be signed against. Incomplete or unsigned applications will not be entertained.
- (2) Submit the <u>original hand-signed</u> application form together with the application fee of <u>HK\$625</u> to the Secretariat of the Veterinary Surgeons Board of Hong Kong (the "Board") to the following address. *Cash must not be sent through the post.* Application fee can be paid either by crossed cheque/bank draft or in person as below.

(a) By Crossed Cheque/ Bank Draft

The crossed cheque or bank draft should be <u>denominated in Hong Kong dollars</u>, and made payable to either "The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region" or "The Government of the HKSAR". Please write your name and purpose of the payment at the back of the crossed cheque/bank draft. You may then post your completed application form together with the crossed cheque/bank draft to the Secretariat of the Board at the following address. <u>Post-dated cheque will not be accepted.</u>

(b) In Person

You may submit the application fee (together with your *completed application form*) in person at the following address –

- (3) The deadline for submission of application is <u>15 December 2017</u>. *Early submission of application is much appreciated*. An extension fee (HK\$625) will invariably be levied on any applications received by the Board after 2017. If you wish to submit your application by post, please <u>ensure your mail items</u> <u>bear sufficient postage before posting</u>. The Board does <u>not</u> accept underpaid mail items. Please also ensure sufficient mailing time to make delivery in order.
- (4) The practising certificate will be sent to you by registered mail <u>within 14</u> working days from the receipt of your application. If you wish to collect the practising certificate in person, please indicate such request in the application form. It will take about 3 working days for payment in cash or 10 working days for payment by cheque for the Board to process your application. You will be notified to collect the practising certificate once it is issued.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1. Section 12 of the Veterinary Surgeons Registration Ordinance (Cap. 529) (the "**Ordinance**") provides that:-
 - "(1) Subject to the payment of the prescribed fee the Secretary shall, on application made to him in that behalf issue to a registered veterinary surgeon a certificate, in a form determined by the Board, to the effect that he is, subject to any conditions and restrictions specified in the certificate, entitled to practise in Hong Kong.
 - (2) Where a practising certificate is issued pursuant to an application made during the course of a year in respect of that year, the certificate shall, subject to section 15(5), be in force from the time of its issue until the end of that year.
 - (3) Where a practising certificate is issued pursuant to an application made during the course of a year in respect of the following year, the certificate shall, subject to section 15(5), be in force for a period of 12 months commencing on 1 January in that following year."
- 2. The address provided in this form is for entry on the practising certificate.
- 3. This address should be your current practising address, or an address at which notices from the Board may be served if you have no current practising address. P.O. Box address is not acceptable.
- 4. Pursuant to section 8(3) of the Ordinance and rule 19 of Rules of the Veterinary Surgeons Board (Registration of Veterinary Surgeons), you are obliged to notify the Secretary to the Board in writing within 28 days of any change to your practising address or address at which notices from the Board may be served.
- 5. Pursuant to sections 12(2) and 12(3) of the Ordinance, once issued, no replacement of the practising certificate due to change of particulars (i.e., name or address) therein, or loss will be entertained.
